In any case, in addition to caring the default or defaults, the person effecting the cure shall pay to the beneficiary all costs and expenses actually incurred in enfercing the obligation of the trust deed together with trustee's and attorney's fees not exceeding the amounts provided by law.

Otherwise, the sale shall be held on the date and at the time and place designated in the notice of sale or the time to which the sale may be postponed as provided by law.
