## FINDINGS OF FACT

The hearings officer finds as follows:

- a. That the property is zoned F.
- b. That no more than 6 guests will be accommodated at any one time.
- c. That this is an ancillary and seasonal use of the property.

## ORDER

Therefore, it is hereby ordered that the applicants request is approved subject to the following conditions:

- a. That no more than 6 guests will be accommodated at any one time.
- b. That approval is obtained for on-site sewage disposal and that the applicant provides proof of clearance from the Environmental Health Services Division and Building department within two (2) years following the date of this order, or obtain an extension of time, or this approval will be void.
- c. That the applicant complies fully with fire safety and other siting standards of the Land Use Code as set out in Article 69 of the LDC.
- d. That all required building and placement permits or an extension of time be obtained within two (2) years following the date of this order or this approval will be void.
- e. That if James Root wishes to upgrade the septic system beyond what is required by the County he may do so at his own expense and may enter onto the property or allow others to do so, for these purposes.
- f. That any parking facilities shall be sited to provide for the maximum feasible protection of all water quality and waterways including springs.
- g. That applicant shall not apply pesticides, herbicides or fertilizers to his property.
- h. That applicant shall not participate in any way in guided tours of any type along Crooked Creek.
- That this permit does not allow for the modification of existing structures to accommodate more guests.

j. That applicant shall progety maintain the roads leading to his property and the parking areas so as to minimize erosion and runoff into the adjacent waterways.
