All documents filed with the court, including lists of the debtor's property, debts, and property claimed as exempt may be inspected at the Bankruptcy Court Clerk's office.

CREDITORS MAY NOT TAKE CERTAIN ACTIONS. A creditor is anyone to whom the debtor owes money or property. Under the Bankruptcy Code, the debtor is granted certain protection against creditors. Common cramples of prohibited actions by creditors are contacting the debtor to collect money own dependence or to take property of the debtor, are contacting the debtor to creditor. LIQUIDATION OF THE DEBTOR'S PROFERTY. The trustee will collect the debtor's property and turn any that is not exempt into money. At this time, however, it appears from the schedules of the debtor that there are no assets from which any distribution can be paid to creditors.
