Section (2) If a charge or assessment or any installment thereof, under ORS. 545-482, 545-484 & 545-494 is not paid when due, interest shall be charged and collected on the charge or assessment or installment at the average of the prime rates charged by all banks in Oregon plus two percent per annum, determined as of the date on which the charge, assessment or installment is due.

Spection (3) If a notice of claim of lien has been filed under ORS. 545-494, the cost of the filing and any cost of removing the lien, including, but not limited to recording and filing fees, title search and a reasonable administrative fee, shall he charged and collected at the time of payment under subsection (1) of this section.
