In construing this instrument and whenever its context so requires, the singular includes the plural.

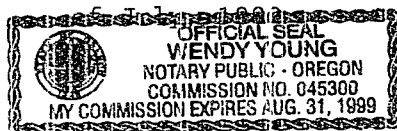

Beginning at a point on the Westerly line of the Old Road leading from Klamath Falls to Keno, at the intersection of said line with the Northerly right of way line of the Weyerhaeuser Timber Company's logging road as same is now constructed; thence North 22°10' East along the West line of said Old Road, 153.25 feet; thence North 67°50' West 148.225 feet; thence North 22°10' East 153.25 feet; thence North 67°50' West 148.225 feet; thence South 22°10' West 281.55 feet to said railroad right of way; thence Southeasterly along said railroad right of way to the place of beginning, being in the NE1/4 SW1/4 of Section 31, Township 39 South, Range 8 East of the Willamette Meridian.
