## DURABLE GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

I, Alice L. Edwards, do hereby make, constitute and appoint, Wesley D. Stone, as my attorney in fact with full power and authority to accomplish the following:

(1) <u>SUPPORT</u>. To make expenditures for my care, maintenance, support and general welfare and to distribute such sums as are necessary for the care, maintenance, education and support of the members of my immediate family who are or become dependent upon me for support.

(2) MANAGEMENT. To take possession of, manage, administer, operate, maintain, improve and control all of my property, real and personal, and to pay any and all takes and assessments that may be levied or imposed upon any of such property.

(3) <u>COLLECTIONS</u>. To collect and receive any money, property, debts or claims whatsoever, now or hereafter due, owing and payable or belonging to me, and to forgive debts and to give receipts, or other sufficient discharges for any of the same.

(4) <u>CHECKS AND NOTES</u>. To sign, endorse, sell, discount, deliver and or deposit checks, notes and any other negotiable or non-negotiable instruments, including any payments to me drawn on the Treasury of the United States or the State of Oregon or any other state or governmental entity.

(5) **INVESTMENTS**. To retain any property in the hands of my attorney in fact in the form in which it was received, and to make investments and changes of investments in such securities or any real or personal property as my attorney in fact may deem prudent.

(6) **<u>DEBTS</u>**. To pay my debts and other obligations.

(7) **LITIGATION.** To sue upon, defend, compromise, submit to arbitration or adjust any controversy in which I may be a party to or interested in, and to act in my name in any complaints, proceedings or suits with all powers that I would possess if personally present and under no legal disability.

(8) **ACOUISITION.** To bargain for, buy and deal in any property and goods of every description.

(9) **<u>DISPOSITION</u>**. To sell, convey, grant, exchange, transfer, mortgage, pledge and lease or otherwise dispose of any of my property whether real or personal.

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(10) **BORROWING**. To advance or loan my attorney in fact's own funds on my behalf and to borrow any sums of money on such terms and at such rate of interest as my attorney in fact may deem proper and to give security for the repayment of the same.

(11) **<u>VOTING</u>**. To appear and vote for me in person or by proxy at any corporate or other meeting.

(12) <u>SAFETY DEPOSIT BOX</u>. To have access to any safety deposit box which has been rented in my name or in the name of myself and any other person or persons.

(13) WITHDRAWAL OF FUNDS. To withdraw any monies deposited with any banks, credit unions, savings and loan associations, mutual funds, money market accounts, investment, advisor, or broker in my name or in the name of myself and any other person or persons and generally do any business with any such financial institution or agency on my behalf.

(14) TAX RETURNS. To sign and file on my behalf all state and federal tax returns or reports.

(15) <u>COVERNMENT DENEFITS</u>. To do and perform every act necessary or desirable and to serve as representative payee with respect to rights and entitlements for my benefit and the benefit of my spouse relative to any Social Security, Medicare or other governmental benefit.

(16) <u>ADDITIONS TO TRUST</u>. To add any and all of my assets to a trust created by me alone or in conjunction with one or more other persons already in existence at the time of creation of this power if the trust provides that the income and principal shall be paid to me or applied for my benefit during my life.

(17) MISCELLANEOUS AUTHORITY.

(a) To continue as a going concern any business interest owned by me, either individually or with other persons.

(b) To act on my behalf in dealing with my pension and retirement plans. (c) To take custody of my with

(c) To take custody of my will, deeds, life insurance policies and any other important papers. (d) To make gifts to other

(d) To make gifts to others on my behalf which may be consistent with any estate planning with the express goal of reducing federal estate taxes.

(e) To renounce and disclaim any property or interest in property or powers to which I may become entitled, and to file any such disclaimer with appropriate courts or persons, and to consider my estate planning and the reduction of estate taxes in exercising such powers.

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(18) ALTERNATE ATTORNEY IN FACT. In the event that, \*\*, is unable or unwilling to act for me as my attorney in fact, I name my \*\*, as my successor and alternate attorney in fact and to have the same powers and authorities as provided in this instrument.

(19) GENERAL AUTHORITY. I authorize my attorney in fact to act for me and in my name and to generally do and perform all and every act and thing necessary or desirable that is in my best interests, and I hereby release all third persons from responsibility for acts and omissions of my attorney in fact, and I empower my attorney in fact to indemnify all such persons against loss, expense and liability.

(20) THIRD PARTY RELIANCE. Third persons may conclusively rely upon the continued validity of this Power of Attorney until receiving actual notice of its revocation. Third persons may conclusively rely on a copy of this instrument in its entirety or any portion thereof certified as such by my attorney in fact.

(21) **<u>DURABILITY</u>**. These powers of attorney shall be exercised by my attorney in fact on my behalf not withstanding that I may become legally disabled or incompetent.

(22) GOVERNING LAW. All questions pertaining to the validity, interpretation and administration of this power shall be determined in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon. Additionally, not withstanding the fact that Oregon law applies and that this instrument was executed within the State of Oregon the same shall be operative in any state where such operability is necessary.
