NOTICE OF REGULATION REQUIRING REPORTING OF CURRENT ADDRESS

NOTICE is hereby given that the following Resolution was adopted by the Board of Directors of the Klamath Basin Improvement District on July 14, 1999.

WHEREAS, the Klamath Basin Improvement District (District) was duly formed and is acting pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Oregon Law provides that the Board of Directors of the District may manage and conduct the business affairs of the District and provide equitable by laws, rules, and

WHEREAS, it is reasonable and necessary for the Board to have and maintain a record of the current name and address of each owner of land in the District for the purposes of conducting elections and for providing notices of assessments and charges and for other business of the

The Board of Directors does hereby resolve and adopt the following regulations and rules:

Any person or entity who owns real property located within, or which is subject to the jurisdiction of the District shall notify the District's Secretary at the District' business office, 6640 KID Lane, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97603, in writing of the owner's current address and within ten days of the change, shall notify the District's Secretary, in writing, of any changes of address. The notice shall include not less than the following information:

A. For an individual, the legal description or Assessor's account number for the land and the full legal name, residential (street) address and mailing address of the owner of the land.

B. For an entity other than an individual, the notice shall specify the legal description or the Assessor's account number for the land, the name, street address, and mailing address of the land owner, and the name, street address and mailing address of one individual who is authorized to represent the ownership in District elections, and who is authorized to receive other notices from the District, including but not limited to notices of charges and assessments and service of process on behalf of the land owner.

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For each land ownership that fails to comply with this regulation, the District shall treat the land owner and address shown on the computer records of the Assessor of Klamath County, Oregon as the designated representative of the owner of the land.

This District shall be deemed to have given proper notice when notice is mailed to the land owner at the address shown on the District's records or if no notice of ownership has been provided to the District, on the Assessor's computer records as of the date the notice is provided.

As used herein, the term "land owner" includes any individual firm, co-partnership, company, association, corporation, estate, trust trustee, receiver, syndicate, or any group or combination acting as a unit.
