ENCROACHMENT PERMIT

The City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, a municipal corporation (City) and Eugene French (Grantee) for and in consideration of the covenants and conditions hereinafter set forth, agree as follows:

City hereby gives and grants to Grantee, his heirs, successors and assigns, upon the terms and subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, non-exclusive permission to encroach upon a portion of the Butte Street right-of-way in the City of Klamath Falls at 3800 Butte Street (as shown on the attached map Exhibit "A"). This permit is granted for the limited purpose of installing a private sanitory sewer service line down Butte Street and is subject to the following conditions:

- Grantee must comply with all relevant local, state and federal regulations pertaining to Grantee's use of the area, including but not limited to, City Planning and building regulations; and
- 2) Grantee must submit the as-built construction plans to the City's Public Works Department and must conform to any modifications or restrictions imposed by the Department.
- 3) Grantee must maintain the service line to the manhole point of connection, must pay the required City Systems Development Charge, comply with City's connection standards and may not connect more than the one residential unit to the service line without City's prior written authorization and in compliance with City's duly adopted rules and regulations.

Grantee agrees to pay to the City, as compensation for the privileges herein granted, the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by City.

Grantee must save and hold harmless the City from, and indemnify the City against, any and all liability for or on account of any death or injury to persons, or damage to property incurred in any manner whatsoever growing out of Grantee's use or the public's loss of the privileges herein granted.

This agreement will run from year to year unless terminated. It may be terminated upon sixty (60) days written notice by either party. Upon termination, Grantee must remove all structures herein authorized and restore the public right-of-way in accordance with the directions of the City's Director of Public Works within sixty (60) days.
