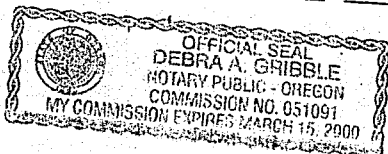

No bid will be considered if received later than 10:00 A.M. November 17, 1999. The bids will be opened and read aloud at 10:15 A.M. November 17, 1999 at 305 Main Street, Klamath Falls, Oregon in Conference Room #232.

Bid security in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid must accompany the bid. All contractors and subcontractors performing work on this project must be licensed with the Oregon Construction Contractors Board. Bidder will be required to com-

plete a certificate of non-discrimination pursuant to ORS 279.111, a certificate of compliance with Oregon tax laws pursuant to ORS 305.380, 305.385, and a bidder residency statement pursuant to ORS 279.029.
