TRUSTEE'S DEED

THIS INDENTURE, Made on November 30, 1999, between Derrick E. Mc Gavic, hereinafter called Trustee, and Associates Housing Finance, LLC, hereinafter called the Second Party; WITNESSETH: RECITALS: JACKIE EUGENE BLANCHARD and PEGGY ANN BLANCHARD Husband and Wife, as Grantor, executed and delivered to Aspen Title and Escrow Company, as Trustee, for the benefit of Ford Consumer Finance Company Inc., as Beneficiary, a certain Trust Deed dated, 1/12/96, recorded 1/31/96, in the Records of Klamath County, Oregon, in book/reel/volume No. M96 at page 2873, and/or as fee/file/instrument/microfilm/reception No. N/A (indicate which). In that Trust Deed, the real property therein and hereinafter described was conveyed by the Grantor to the Trustee to secure, among other things, the performance of certain obligations of the Grantor to the Beneficiary. The Grantor thereafter defaulted in performance of the obligations secured by the trust deed as stated in the notice of default hereinafter mentioned, and such default still existed at the time of the sale hereinafter described.

By reason of the default, the owner and holder of the obligations secured by the Trust Deed, being the Beneficiary therein named, or the Beneficiary's successor in interest, declared all sums so secured immediately due and owing. A notice of default containing an election to sell the real property and to foreclose the trust deed by advertisement and sale to satisfy the asserting Grantor's obligations was recorded on June 16, 1999, the Records of Klamath County, in book/reel/volume No. M99 at page 23675, and/or as fee/file instrument microfilm/reception No. N/A, (indicate which), to which reference now is made.

After recording the notice of default, the undersigned Trustee gave notice of the time for and place of sale of the real property, as fixed by the Trustee and as required by law. Copies of the notice of sale were served pursuant to ORCP 7 D. (2) and 7 D. (3), or mailed by both first class and certified mail with return receipt requested, to the last known addresses of the persons or their legal representatives, if any, named in ORS 86.740 (1) and 86.740(2)(a), at least 120 days before the date the property was sold. A copy of the notice of sale was mailed by first class and certified mail with return receipt requested to the last known address of the fiduciary or personal representative of any person named in ORS 86.740 (1), promptly after the Trustee received knowledge of the disability, insanity or death of any such person. Copies of the notice of sale were served upon occupants of the property described in the trust deed in the manner in which a summons is served pursuant to ORCP 7 D. (2) and 7 D. (3) at least 120 days before the date the property was sold, pursuant to ORS 86.750 (1). If the foreclosure proceedings were stayed and released from the stay, copies of an amended notice of sale in the form required by ORS 86.755 (6) were mailed by registered or certified mail to the last known addresses of those persons listed in ORS 86.740 and 86.750 (1) and to the address provided by each person who was present the time and place set for the sale which was stayed within 30 days after the release from the stay. The Trustee published a copy of the notice of sale in a newspaper of general circulation in each county in which the real property is situated once a week for four successive weeks. The last publication of the notice occurred more than twenty days prior to the date of sale. The mailing, service and publication of the notice of sale are shown by affidavits and/or proof of service duly recorded prior to the date of sale in the county records, those affidavits and proofs, together with the Notice of Default and Election to Sell and the Notice of Sale, being now referred to and incorporated in and made a part of this deed as if fully set forth herein. The undersigned Trustee has no actual notice of any person, other than the

persons named in those affidavits and proofs as having or claiming a lien on or interest in the real property, entitled to notice pursuant to ORS 86.740 (1)(b) or (1)(c).

The true and actual consideration for this conveyance is \$ 92,302.57. (Here comply with ORS 93.030.)

The undersigned Trustee, on November 29, 1999, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock, A.M., in accord with the standard of time established by ORS 187.110, (which was the day and hour to which the sale was postponed as permitted by ORS 86.755 (2)) (which was the day and hour set in the amended notice of sale)* and at the place so fixed for sale, in full accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon and pursuant to the powers conferred upon the Trustee by the trust deed, sold the real property in one parcel at public auction to the second party for the sum of \$92,302.57, the second party being the highest and best bidder at the sale, and that sum being the highest and best bid for the property.
