


DEED RESTRICTION

The purpose of this document is to place a deed restriction on the northeast half of Lot 6, Block 24, Original Town of Linkville (now City of Klamath Falls) so that this parcel, more particularly described below, can only be transferred by simultaneous transfer to the same owner of Lot 7, Block 24, Original Town of Linkville. As of the date of execution of this document, Lots 6 and 7 of Block 24, Original Town of Linkville are owned in fee simple by Klamath County.


The particular description of that portion of Lot 6, Block 24 of the Original Town of Linkville, which can only be transferred with Lot 7, Block 24 of the Original Town of Linkville is as follows:

Beginning at the most Southerly corner of Lot 6, Block 24, Original Town of Linkville (now City of Klamath Falls) according to the official plat thereof on file in the office of the County Clerk of Klamath County, Oregon; thence North 66° 42' East, along said lot boundary, 24.16 feet to a 5/8" iron pin for the true point of beginning of this description; thence North 23° 16' 32" West, parallel with the Southwesterly boundary of said lot, 119.90 feet to the Northerly boundary of said lot; thence North 66° 42' East, along the Northerly boundary of said lot, 24.17 feet to the most Northerly corner of said Lot 6; thence South 23° 16' 32" East, 119.90 feet to the most Easterly corner of said Lot 6; thence South 66° 42' West, along said lot boundary, 24.17 feet to the true point of beginning.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the grantor has executed this instrument on March 23, 2000; if grantor is a corporation, it has caused its name to be signed and its seal, if any, affixed by an officer or other person duly authorized to do so by order of its board of directors.




