15 This matter come before the Court for trial on March 10, 2000. Petitioner and
16 Respondent were personally present and appeared pro se. Respondent made an oral motion to
17 convert the Petition for Unlimited Separation to a Petition for Dissolution of Marriage and his
18 motion was granted. The Court being fully advised, makes the following findings:

- 19 1. The parties were married in Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon on June 27,
20 1983, and have ever since been husband and wife.
- 21 2. There is no other domestic suit or support petition pending between the parties
22 in this or any other state.
- 23 3. The court has jurisdiction over the parties.
- 24 4. For a period of six (6) months immediately prior to the filing of the Petition for
25 Unlimited Separation, one or both parties were residents of the state of Oregon.
- 26 5. Irreconcilable differences exist between the parties and have caused the irremedial

breakdown of the marriage.

6. There are no children of this marriage and the Petitioner is not pregnant.

Now therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. The parties' marriage is hereby dissolved, effective immediately.

REAL PROPERTY DISTRIBUTION

2. The parties own residential property, located at 152375 Wagon Trail Road, and two undeveloped parcels in LaPine, Oregon. Petitioner is awarded the undeveloped parcels. Respondent is awarded the residential property. Each respective property award shall be subject to all liens and encumbrances thereon.

PERSONAL PROPERTY DISTRIBUTION

3. The parties have acquired certain assets and personal property during their marriage. Those items have already been equitably divided between the parties. Each party is awarded the assets and personal property currently in his or her possession.

DEBTS

4. Each party shall be responsible for the payment of all debts incurred by them individually since the date of their separation on November 1, 1998. Respondent shall be required to pay all marital debts, including but not limited to the federal and state income tax deficiencies incurred prior to November 1, 1998.
