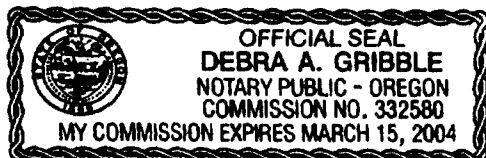

-Bid security in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of bid must accompany the bid. All contractors and subcontractors performing work on this project must be licensed with the Oregon Construction Contractors Board. Pursuant to ORS 279.029, 279.111 and 305.380 through 305.385 bidder will be required to complete a Bidder Residency Statement, Certificate of Non-Discrimination and a Certificate of Compliance with Oregon Tax Laws.

Klamath County may reject any bid not in compliance with all prescribed public bidding procedures and requirements, and may for good cause reject any or all bids upon a finding of the agency it is in the public interest to do so.
