AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, Weyerhaeuser Company, predecessor in interest to **COLLINS PRODUCTS LLC**, hereinafter called first party, and **PG&E GAS TRANSMISSION, NORTHWEST CORPORATION**, a California corporation, hereinafter called second party, entered into that certain Right of Way Easement dated May 22, 1995 and recorded in Vol. M95 at Page 26798 of Official Records of Klamath County, Oregon; and second party subsequently filed Notice of Location dated November 5, 1996 in Vol. M96 at Page 36405 of Official Records of Klamath County, Oregon to further define the location of the parcel described in said Right of Way Easement;

It is agreed between the parties that the exclusive easement in Section 18, T 39 S, 9 E, W.M., will be 128' x 105', as shown on the map recorded in the Klamath County Surveyor's Office, #6517.

All other terms and condition of the above referenced Right of Way Easement shall remain the same. The provisions herein granted shall inure to the benefit of and bind the heirs, successors, and assigns of the respective parties hereto, and all covenants shall apply to and run with the land.
