ORDINANCE NO. 00-17

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS, LOCATED AT 2226 WASHBURN WAY

WHEREAS, there has been submitted to the City of Klamath Falls a written proposal for annexation of certain real property by the Klamath Falls City Council thereof, which property is hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held on August 14, 2000, pursuant to applicable laws at which time all objections or remonstrances with reference to said proposed annexation were considered by the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hearing notice having been duly given, did hold a public hearing on August 21, 2000 on the annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Council has adopted the findings of the Planning Commission, attached hereto and incorporated by this reference as Exhibit C, determining the annexation to be in compliance with the Comprehensive Plan and Community Development Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Council did determine annexation of said property to be in the best interest of the City and the continuous territory; and

WHEREAS, the City of Klamath Falls adopted a Comprehensive Plan for the City on April 20, 1982, by virtue of Ordinance No. 6336; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such record and hearing, the City Council has determined the annexation to be in compliance with the Community development Ordinance and the Comprehensive Plan;




EXHIBIT B

A tract of land situated in Lot 1, Block 2, Tract 1080-Washburn Park, a duly recorded subdivision, Section 04, Township 39S, Range 9E of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon, more particularly described as follows:

EXHIBIT C

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FINDINGS

- 1. The annexation will not encroach upon agricultural lands.
- 2. The annexation will not encroach upon forestlands.
- 3. The annexation will not help conserve open space and protect natural resources as the property does not contain viable open space or any natural resources.
- 4. The annexation will not adversely affect the quality of the community's air, water and land resources.
- 5. The annexation will not endanger life or property from natural disasters or hazards.
- 6. The annexation will not help satisfy the citizen's recreation needs as the property is currently zoned general commercial and recreation is not a viable amenity at this site.
- 7. The annexation will diversify and improve the community's economy.
- 8. The annexation will not help satisfy the community's housing needs as the property is zoned general commercial.
- 9. The annexation will create a timely, orderly, and efficient arrangement of public facilities and services.
- 10. The annexation will not help provide a safe, convenient and economic transportation system as the transportation already exists.
- 11. The annexation will not aid in energy conservation.
- 12. The annexation will promote an orderly and efficient transition from rural to urban land uses.
