WHEREAS, on this matter before the Klamath County Board of Commissioners it appears that certain parties holding an interest in the real property known as tax lot R-3407-034DA-02900 and a mobile home known as M-170056 were not served notice of foreclosure during the redemption period. The parcel and mobile home were included in Foreclosure No. 9700001FR and deeded to Klamath County on January 19, 2000, in Volume M00, Page 1764. The property and mobile home are described as:

The Northwesterly one-half of Lot 4 and all of Lots 5 and 6 in Block 2 of First Addition To Chiloquin, Oregon, according to the official plat thereof on file in the office of the County Clerk of Klamath County, Oregon.

NOW THEREFORE, it is ordered that the above described parcel and mobile home are removed from the foreclosure deed recorded on January 19, 2000, in Volume M00, Page 1764.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Judgment and Decree dated January 9, 1998, for Foreclosure No. 9700001FR is still effective.
