RELINQUISHMENT OF RESERVATION
(Easement Release)

Vol M00 Page 40880

WHEREAS, the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, acting by and through the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture, pursuant to the Act of March 20, 1922, as amended (16 U.S.C. 485) conveyed certain lands in T. 32 S., R. 7-1/2 E., W.M. by Patent No. 36-71-0001, issued to the State of Oregon by the Bureau of Land Management, Department of the Interior, signed August 5, 1970, and recorded August 27, 1970 in Vol. M-70, page 7508, Klamath County records.

WHEREAS, said Patent contained the following reservation by the United States:

An easement for an existing road, known as the Sun Pass Road, over and across the E1/2 Sec. 22, S1/2 Sec. 23, S1/2 Sec. 24, and E1/2NE1/4 Sec. 25, T. 32 S., R. 7-1/2 E., W.M., being 66 feet in width, 33 feet on each side of the centerline of the road as constructed on the ground, with as much additional width as required for adequate protection of cuts and fills, said centerline being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Sun Pass Highway approximately 105 feet northerly and 1,220 feet westerly from the quarter corner between Sections 22 and 23; thence southeasterly to a point on the east section line of Sec. 22 approximately 1,715 feet north of the section corner common to Sections 22, 23, 26, and 27; thence, easterly over and across Sec. 23 to a point on the east section line of Sec. 23 approximately 1,485 feet northerly of the section corner common to Sections 23, 24, 25, and 26; thence easterly and southerly to a point on the south line of Sec. 24 approximately 395 feet westerly from the southeast corner of said section 24; thence southeasterly to a point on the east section line of Sec. 25, approximately 1,320 feet southerly from the northeast corner of said Sec. 25.

Whereas, SAID patent also included the following language:


PROVIDED, that if for a period of 5 years, the United States, or its assigns, shall cease to use, or preserve for prospective future use, the above road, or any segment thereof, for the purposes reserved, or if at any time the United States of America determines that the above road, or any segment thereof, is no longer needed, the easement traversed thereby shall terminate. In the event of such nonuse or of such determination by the United States of America, the United States of America shall furnish to the State of Oregon, or its assigns, a statement in recordable form evidencing termination in accordance with provisions of the Act of February 28, 1925 (43 Stat. 1090).

NOW THEREFORE, this instrument is executed for the purpose of relinquishing any right, title or interest in and to the reservation for the Sun Pass Road No. 2302, as described above unto the State of Oregon and its assigns.






