According to the provisions of ORS 368.341(3) and ORS 368.351, a petition containing the acknowledged signatures of the owners of 100% of the property abutting the public property described in Exhibit "A", included hereto and by this reference incorporated herein, proposed to be vacated and indicating said owners' approval of the proposed vacation was filed with the Board of Commissioners on January 31, 2001.

Thereafter, the Public Works Director filed with the Commissioners a written report containing the required information of ORS 368.346(1), finding the vacation to be in the public interest.

Now, after fully considering the report and other documentation presented, the Board of County Commissioners find that the vacation of Ewauna Way West of Maywood Drive in the Plat of Enterprise Tracts in Sections 4 and 9, Township 39 South, Range 9 east of the Willamette Meridian, in Klamath County, Oregon, as described in Exhibit "A", included hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, is in the public interest and finds that the petition should be granted and that the property vacated would benefit the public by being placed on the tax rolls. This Order stipulates that the vacation is subject to easements for existing public utilities to operate facilities in the vacated areas.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition is granted and that the portion described herein is vacated, as said vacation in the public interest. It is further ordered that pursuant to ORS 365.366(1)(d) the vacated property is vested in the owners of the abutting property by extension of their property boundaries.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the costs resulting from the approved vacation is determined to be in the sum of \$100.00 and that the persons liable for payment of the costs are the petitioners, who have paid the above mentioned sum on February 6, 2001.

BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS VACATION OF EWAUNA WAY WEST OF MAYWOOD DR. SUBJECT: IN ENTERPRISE TRACTS SUBDIVISION, KLAMATH COUNTY, OREGON (See attached map and description)

The Board of County Commissioners accepted the petition for vacation and referred it to the County Road Official by Order #2001-073 on February 15, 2001. According to the County Assessor's records, the owner of all the property abutting this portion of the road is the South Suburban Sanitary District. Therefore, notice to the adjoining owners was not required.

Notice was provided to all utility companies in the area. Pacific Power & Light Company has facilities in the area to be vacated.

The portion of Ewauna Way proposed to be vacated is currently being used as a driveway and for sewage sanitation ponds by South Suburban Sanitary District and is not needed to access other properties in the area.

Returning the property to the tax rolls would benefit the public. I recommend the property described in the petition be vacated. The order should stipulate that the vacation is subject to an easement for utilities to operate their existing facilities in the vacated area.
