10. EVENTS OF DEFAULT. The occurrence of any of the following events shall, at Beneficiary's option, and at any time without regard to any previous knowledge on Beneficiary's part, constitute a default under the terms of this Deed of Trust, the Secured Obligation and all related loan documents: 10.1 NON-PAYMENT OF PRINCIPAL OR INTEREST. Any payment of principal or interest on the Secured Obligation is not made when due; or 10.2 FAILURE TO PERFORM. Any tax, assessment, insurance premium, lien, encumbrance or other charge against the Property, or any payment under a real estate contract covering the Property is not paid when due; or any other term, covenant or agreement of Grantor contained in this Deed of Trust or in any other document with Beneficiary, or in which Grantor grants a security interest in the Property, is not contained in this Deed of Trust or in any other document with Beneficiary, or in which Grantor grants a security interest in the Property, is not promptly performed or satisfied.

11. REMEDIES UPON DEFAULT. If any default occurs and is continuing, Beneficiary may, at its option:

11.1 TERMINATE COMMITMENT. Terminate any outstanding and unfulfilled commitment to Grantor;

11.2 ACCELERATE. Declare any or all of the Secured Obligation, together with all accrued interest, to be immediately due and payable without presentment, demand, protest or notice of any kind, all of which are expressly waived by Grantor;

11.3 PAYMENTS. Pay such sums as may be necessary to pay any tax, assessment, insurance premium, lien, encumbrance or other charge against the Property, or any payment under a real estate contract covering the Property, without prejudice to Beneficiary's right to accelerate the Secured Obligation and foreclose upon this Deed of Trust. Grantor shall reimburse Beneficiary, upon demand, for all such amounts paid by Beneficiary, with interest thereon from the date of such payment at the highest rate that is, from time to time, applicable on any of the Secured Obligation. All unreimbursed amounts shall be added to and become a part of the Secured Obligation;

11.4 REINSTATEMENT. The Grantor shall have the right to reinstate this Deed of Trust and have any proceedings begun by the Beneficiary to enforce this Deed of Trust discontinued at any time prior to the earlier to occur (1) the fifth day before the date of sale by the Trustee, or (2) the entry of a judgment foreclosing this Deed of Trust. The conditions for reinstatement are that: (a) the Grantor pays off sums, which would then be due under the Secured Obligation and this Deed of Trust had no acceleration occurred; (b) cure any default of Grantor's other obligations or agreements in this Deed of Trust; (c) pay all costs and expenses actually incurred by Beneficiary in enforcing this Deed of Trust and the obligations secured herby shall remain fully effective a promptly performed or satisfied.

12. WAIVER. No waiver by Beneficiary of any deviation by Grantor from full performance of this Deed of Trust or the Secured Obligation, as the case may be, shall constitute a waiver of Beneficiary's right to require prompt payment or to assert any other right or remedy provided for in this Deed of Trust or the Secured Obligation on the basis of the same or similar failure to perform.

13. SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS. This Deed of Trust inures to the benefit of and is binding upon the respective heirs, devisees, legatees, administrators, executors, successors and assigns of the parties hereto.

14. APPLICABLE LAW. This Deed of Trust has been delivered to Beneficiary and accepted by Beneficiary in the State of Oregon. This Deed of Trust shall be governed by and in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon.

15. PLEDGE. Any Grantor who is not a borrower under the Secured Obligation shall not be personally liable for the obligations therein and is only signing this Deed of Trust to grant and convey Grantor's interest in the real property identified herein and agrees that Beneficiary and any borrower under the Secured Obligation may extend, modify, forebear, or make any other arrangements relating to the Secured Obligation or Deed of Trust thour Grantor's consent and without releasing Grantor from this Deed of Trust, its extension or modification.
