WARRANTY DEED—SURVIVORSHIP

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That E.A. Mary Hague aka Mary Hague & E.A. Mary Hague Edna Alfreda Mary Hague hereinafter called the grantor, for the consideration hereinafter stated to the grantor paid by Judith E. Hunter Janice M. Yates and Frances E. Davis hereinafter called grantees, hereby grants, bargains, sells and conveys unto the grantees, not as tenants in common but with the right of survivorship, their assigns and the heirs of the survivor of the grantees, the following described real property with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any way appertaining, situated in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, to-wit:

Bly 1st addition, Block 15 Lot 5
 Bly 1st addition Block 15, Lot 6
 Bly 1st addition Block 15 Lot 7
 Bly 1st addition Block 15 Lot 8

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described and granted premises unto the grantees, their assigns and the heirs of such survivor, forever; provided that the grantees herein do not take the title in common but with the right of survivorship, that is, that the fee shall vest absolutely in the survivor of the grantees.

And the grantor above named hereby covenants to and with the above named grantees, their heirs and assigns, that grantor is lawfully seized in fee simple of the premises, that same are free from all encumbrances

and that grantor will warrant and forever defend the premises and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, except those claiming under the above described encumbrances.

The true and actual consideration paid for this transfer, stated in terms of dollars, is \$ 0.

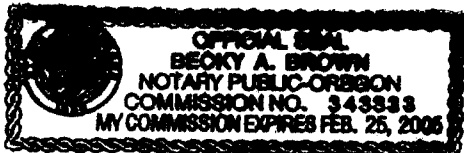
