TRUSTEE'S DEED

THIS INDENTURE, made this 14th day of September, 2001, between DAVID E. FENNELL, hereinafter called the Trustee and Altegra Credit Company, hereinafter called the second party;

RECITALS:

RECITALS: Larry W. Caldwell, an unmarried person, as grantors, executed and delivered to: Chicago Title Insurance Company, as trustee, for the benefit of First Franklin Financial Corporation, as beneficiary, a trust deed dated 12/10/99, duly recorded on 12/30/99 in the mortgage records of Klamath County, Oregon in Volume M99 Page 51178 and subsequently assigned to Altegra Credit Company by Assignment recorded as Volume M01 Page 14587. In the trust deed, the real property described below ("Property") was conveyed by the grantor to the trustee to secure, among other things, the performance of the grantor's obligations to the beneficiary. Further, the trustee published a copy of the Trustee's Notice of Sale in a newspaper of general circulation in each county in which the Property is located, once a week for four successive weeks; the last publication of Notice of Trustee's Sale occurred more than twenty days prior to the date of sale. The mailing, service and publication of the Trustee's Notice of Sale are evidenced by one or more affidavits or proofs of service duly recorded prior to the date of sale in the official records of the county in which the Property is located.
