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UNDERGROUND DISTRIBUTION RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT

Said property generally located in the SW ¼ of Section 35, Township 48N, Range 4E, of the Mount Diablo Meridian, and more specifially described in Volume 340 Page 521 in the Official Records of Siskiyou County.

Assessor's Map No. <u>50-18</u> Tax Parcel No. <u>50-181-010</u> Together with the right of access to the right of way from adjacent lands of Grantor for all activities in connection with the purposes for which this easement has been granted; and together with the present and (without payment therefor) the future right to keep the right of way and adjacent lands clear of all brush, trees, timber, structures and other hazards which might endanger Grantee's facilities or impede Grantee's activities.

At no time shall Grantor erect or permit the erection of any buildings or structures of any kind or nature within the right of way without the prior written consent of Grantee, or light any fires, or place or store any flammable materials (other than agricultural crops), on or within the boundaries of the right of way. Subject to the foregoing limitations, the surface of the right of way may be used for roads, agricultural crops and other purposes not inconsistent with the purposes for which this easement has been granted.
