ENCROACHMENT PERMIT

The City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, a municipal corporation (City) and David H. Panossian and Teresa R. Panossian, husband and wife, (Grantee) for and in consideration of the covenants and conditions hereinafter set forth, agree as follows:

City hereby gives and grants to Grantee, its successors and assigns, upon the terms and subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, non-exclusive permission to encroach upon a portion of the generally east side of the Almond Street right-of-way in the City of Klamath Falls at 2614 Almond Street (as shown on the attached map Exhibit "A"). This permit is granted for the limited purpose of placing two (2) single-fixture anodized bronze parking lot lights, including necessary wire and conduit, and a planter box (all as depicted on Exhibit "A") and is subject to the following conditions:

- 1) Grantee shall comply with all relevant local, state and federal regulations pertaining to Grantee's use of the area, including but not limited to, City Planning and building regulations;
- Grantee shall submit the as-built construction plans to the City's Public Works Department and shall conform to any modifications or restrictions imposed by the Department; and
- Grantee shall be responsible: for the maintenance of the planter, lights, fixtures, conduit and wire; for payment of all utilities associated with the lights and planter; for all expenses for removal of all right-of-way improvements as required under this permit; and for restoration of the right-of-way damaged by such maintenance or removal.

Grantee agrees to pay to the City, as compensation for the privileges herein granted, the sum of Eighty-One Dollars (\$81.00), receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by City.

Grantee shall save and hold harmless the City from, and indemnify the City against, any and all liability for or on account of any death or injury to persons, or damage to property incurred in any manner whatsoever growing out of Grantee's use or the public's loss of the privileges herein granted.

Encroachment Permit, Page 1

This agreement shall run from year to year unless terminated. It may be terminated upon sixty (60) days written notice by either party. Upon termination, Grantee shall remove all structures herein authorized and restore the public right-of-way in accordance with the directions of the City's Director of Public Works within sixty (60) days.


