TRUST DEED

This Subordination Agreement (the "Agreement"), is made and entered into as of June 18, 2002, by and between Sharon Trunkey and Glennda Gentle (together referred to herein as the "First Lender"), Desert Lake Technologies, LLC (the "Debtor") and Richard L. Wendt (the "Second Lender").

Whereas, the Debtor and/or Desert lake Technologies, Incorporated, a Delaware Corporation are indebted to the First Lender on an initial loan of approximately \$1,371,292.00, which loan is secured and potentially perfected by a UCC Financing Statement recorded with the state of Oregon March 16, 2000, a copy of which is attached in Appendix A and two Trust Deeds, dated March 2000 and recorded March 8, 2000 a description of which is attached in Appendix B (together, the "First Liens");

Whereas, the Debtor has had difficulty acquiring financing from lending institutions and would like the Second Lender to lend money to the Debtor;

Whereas, the First Lender would like the Second Lender to lend the Debtor money so that the First Lender has a better likelihood of being paid amounts that will be due on its loan to Debtor;

Whereas, the Second Lender is willing to extend a loan in the amount of \$1,500,000 at prime minus 0.5% interest to the Debtor, but requires that the First Lender subordinate its secured loan and security interests to the Second Lender's secured loan and security interests (together, the "Second Liens");

Now Therefore, for value received and for the purpose of inducing the Second Lender to make the loan aforesaid, the Debtor, the First Lender and the Second Lender agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Subordination</u>. Any and all claims of the First Lender against the Debtor, now or hereafter existing, including the First Liens, are and will be at all times, subject and subordinate to any and all claims, now or hereafter existing which the Second Lender may have against Debtor pursuant to a business loan agreement between Debtor and the Second Lender providing for a loan in the principal amount of \$1,500,000 (the "Loan Agreement").
- 2. Lawsuits. For so long as any claim by the Second Lender related to the Loan Agreement and against the Debtor exists, the First Lender agrees not to sue upon, collect or resolve payment of the principal or interest of any claim or claims now or hereafter existing which the First Lender may hold against the Debtor and not to sell, assign, transfer, pledge, hypothecate or encumber the claim or claims except as permitted by this Agreement and not to

demand any security now or hereafter existing therefrom, nor to file or join in any petition to commence any proceeding under the federal bankruptcy laws against the Debtor nor to take any lien or security on any of the Debtor's property real or personal.

In construing this subordination agreement and where the context so requires, the singular includes the plural; the masculine includes the feminine and the neuter, and all grammatical changes shall be supplied to cause this agreement to apply to corporations as well as to individuals.


