## TRUST DEED

(Assignment Restricted)

THIS DEED OF TRUST, made this **Twenty-seventh day of December, 2002**, between **Gregory J. Conlin and Robert L. Smith**, as GRANTOR, and , as TRUSTEE, and **Randolph Allen and Judy E. Allen**, as BENEFICIARY.

**WITNESSETH:** Grantor irrevocably conveys to Trustee in trust, with power of sale, certain real property in **Klamath County, Oregon** , described as:

See Legal Description attached hereto as Exhibit A and by this reference incorporated herein.

Together with all singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances and all other rights thereunto belonging or in any way now or hereafter appertaining, and the rents, issues, and profits thereof, together with all fixtures now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with said real estate.

FOR THE PURPOSE OF SECURING PERFORMANCE of each agreement of Grantor herein contained and payment of the sum of **Twenty Three Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty dollars (\$23,950.00)**, with interest thereon according to the terms of a promissory note of even date herewith, payable to Beneficiary or order, and made by Grantor, the final payment of principal and interest hereof, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable .

**Note:** The Trust Deed Act provides that the Trustee hereunder must be either an attorney who is an active member of the Oregon State Bar, a bank, trust company or savings and loan association authorized to do business under the laws of Oregon or the United States, a title insurance company authorized to insure title to real property of the state, its subsidiaries, affiliates, agents or branches, the United States or any agency thereof, or an escrow agent licensed under ORS 896.505 to 896.585.

The date of maturity of the debt secured by this instrument is the date, stated above, on which the final installment of the Note becomes due and payable. Should the Grantor either agree to, attempt to, or actually sell, convey, or assign all (or any part) of the property, or all (or any part) of Grantor's interest in it without first obtaining the written consent or approval of the Beneficiary, then, at the Beneficiary's option\*, all obligations secured by this instrument, irrespective of the maturity dates expressed therein, or herein, shall become immediately due and payable. The execution by Grantor of an earnest money agreement does not constitute a sale, conveyance or assignment.

**To protect the security of this Trust Deed, Grantor agrees:**

1. To protect, preserve and maintain the property in good condition and repair; not to remove or demolish any building or improvement therein; not to commit or permit any waste of said property.

2. To complete or restore promptly and in good and habitable condition any building or improvement, which may be constructed, damaged or destroyed thereon, and pay when due all costs incurred therefor.

3. To comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations, covenants, conditions and restrictions affecting the property; if the Beneficiary so requests, to join in executing such financing statements pursuant to the Uniform Commercial Code as the Beneficiary may require, and to pay for filing the same in the proper public office or offices, as well as the cost of all lien searches made by filing officers or searching agencies as may be deemed desirable by the Beneficiary.

4. ~~To provide and continuously maintain insurance on the buildings now or hereafter erected on the said property against loss or damage by fire and other hazards as the Beneficiary may from time to time require, in an amount not less than \$23,950.00, written by one or more companies acceptable to the Beneficiary, with loss payable to the latter. All policies of insurance shall be delivered to the Beneficiary as soon as issued. If the Grantor shall fail for any reason to procure any such insurance and to deliver the policies to the Beneficiary at least fifteen days prior to the expiration of any policy or insurance now or hereafter placed on the buildings, the Beneficiary may procure the same at Grantor's expense. The amount collected under any fire or other insurance policy may be applied by Beneficiary upon any indebtedness secured hereby and in such order as Beneficiary may determine, or at option of Beneficiary the entire amount so collected, or any part thereof, may be released to Grantor. Such application or release shall not cure or waive any default or notice of default hereunder or invalidate any act done pursuant to such notice.~~

5. To keep said premises free from construction liens and to pay all taxes, assessments and other charges that may be levied or assessed upon or against said property before any part of such taxes, assessments and other charges become past due or delinquent and promptly deliver receipt of payment to Beneficiary. Should the Grantor fail to make payment of any taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, liens or other charges payable by Grantor, either by direct payment or by providing Beneficiary with funds with which to make such payment, Beneficiary may, at its option, make payment thereof, and the amount so paid, with interest at the rate set forth in the note secured hereby, together with the obligations described in paragraphs 6 and 7 of this Trust Deed, shall be added to and become a part of the debt secured by this Trust Deed, without waiver of any rights arising from breach of any of the covenants hereof. For such payments, with interest as aforesaid, the property herein before described, as well as the Grantor, shall be bound to the same extent that they are bound for the payment of the obligation herein described. All such payments shall be immediately due and payable without notice, and the nonpayment thereof shall, at the option of the Beneficiary, render all sums secured by this Trust Deed immediately due and payable and constitute a breach of this Trust Deed.

6. To pay all costs, fees and expenses of this trust including the cost of title search, as well as the other costs and expenses of the Trustee incurred in connection with or in enforcing this obligation together with trustees' and attorneys' fees actually incurred.

7. To appear in and defend any action or proceeding purporting to affect the security rights or powers of Beneficiary or Trustee; and in any suit, action or proceeding in which the Beneficiary or Trustee may appear, including any suit for the foreclosure of this Deed or any suit or action related to this instrument, including but not limited to its validity and/or enforceability, to pay all costs and expenses, including evidence of title and the Beneficiary's or Trustee's attorneys' fees. The amount of attorneys' fees mentioned in this paragraph in all cases shall be fixed by the trial court, and in the event of an appeal from any judgment or decree of the trial court, Grantor further agrees to pay such sum as the appellate court shall adjudge reasonable as the Beneficiary's or Trustee's attorneys' fees on such appeal.

**It is mutually agreed that:**

8. In the event that any portion or all of the property shall be taken under the right of eminent domain or condemnation, Beneficiary shall have the right, if it so elects, to require that all or any portion of the monies payable as compensation for such taking which are in excess of the amount required to pay all reasonable costs, expenses and attorney fees necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor in such proceedings, shall be paid to Beneficiary and applied by it first upon any reasonable costs and expenses and attorney fees, both in the trial and appellate courts, necessarily paid or incurred by Beneficiary in such proceedings, and the balance applied upon the indebtedness secured hereby. Grantor agrees, at its own expense, to take such actions and execute such instruments as shall be necessary in obtaining such compensation promptly upon Beneficiary's request.

9. At any time, and from time to time upon written request of Beneficiary, payment of its fees and presentation of this deed and the note for endorsement (In case of full reconveyances, for cancellation), without affecting the liability of any person for the payment of the indebtedness, Trustee may (a) consent to the making of any map or plat of the property; (b) join in granting any easement or creating any restriction thereon; (c) join in any subordination or other agreement affecting this deed or the lien or

charge thereof; or (d) reconvey, without warranty, all or any part of the property. The Grantee in any reconveyance may be described as the "person or persons legally entitled thereto," and the recitals therein of any matters or facts shall be conclusive proof of the truthfulness thereof. Trustee fees for any of the services mentioned in this paragraph shall be not less than \$5.00.

10. Upon any default by Grantor hereunder, Beneficiary may, at any time without notice, either in person, by agent, or by a receiver to be appointed by a court, and without regard to the adequacy of any security for the indebtedness hereby secured, enter upon and take possession of the property or any part thereof, in its own name sue or otherwise collect the rents, issues and profits, including those past due and unpaid, and apply the same, less costs and expenses of operation and collection, including reasonable attorney fees, upon any indebtedness secured hereby, and in such order as Beneficiary may determine.

11. The entering upon and taking possession of the property, the collection of such rents, issues and profits, or the proceeds of fire and other insurance policies or compensation or awards for any taking or damage of the property, and the application or release thereof as aforesaid, shall not cure or waive any default or notice of default hereunder, or invalidate any act done pursuant to such notice.

12. Upon default by Grantor in payment of any indebtedness secured hereby or in Grantor's performance of any agreement hereunder, time being of the essence with respect to such payment and/or performance, the Beneficiary may declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable. In such event, the Beneficiary may elect to proceed to foreclose this trust deed in equity as a mortgage or direct the Trustee to foreclose this trust deed by advertisement and sale, or may direct the Trustee to pursue any other right or remedy, either at law or in equity, which the Beneficiary may have. In the event the Beneficiary elects to foreclose by advertisement and sale, the Beneficiary or the Trustee shall execute and cause to be recorded a written notice of default and election to sell the property to satisfy the obligation secured hereby whereupon the Trustee shall fix the time and place of sale, give notice thereof as then required by law and proceed to foreclose this trust deed in the manner provided in ORS 86.735 to 86.795.

13. After the Trustee has commenced foreclosure by advertisement and sale, and at any time prior to 5 days before the date the Trustee conducts the sale, the Grantor or any other person so privileged by ORS 86.763 may cure the default or defaults. If the default consists of a failure to pay, when due, sums secured by the trust deed, the default may be cured by paying the entire amount due at the time of the cure other than such portion as would not then be due had no default occurred. Any other default that is capable of being cured may be cured by tendering the performance required under the obligation or trust deed. In any case, in addition to curing the default or defaults, the person effecting the cure shall pay to the Beneficiary all costs and expenses actually incurred in enforcing the obligation of the trust deed, together with trustee and attorney fees not exceeding the amounts provided by law.

14. Otherwise, the sale shall be held on the date and at the time and place designated in the notice of sale or the time to which the sale may be postponed as provided by law. The Trustee may sell the property either in one parcel or in separate parcels and shall sell the parcel or parcels at auction to the highest bidder for cash, payable at the time of sale. Trustee shall deliver to the purchaser its deed in form as required by law conveying the property so sold, but without any covenant or warranty, express or implied. The recitals in the deed of any matters of fact shall be conclusive proof of the truthfulness thereof. Any person, excluding the Trustee, but including the Grantor and Beneficiary, may purchase at the sale.

15. When Trustee sells pursuant to the powers provided herein, Trustee shall apply the proceeds of sale to payment of: (1) the expense of sale, including the compensation of the Trustee and a reasonable charge by Trustee's attorney; (2) to the obligation secured by the trust deed; (3) to all persons having recorded liens subsequent to the interest of the trust deed as their interests may appear in the order of their priority; and (4) the surplus, if any, to the Grantor, or to any successor in interest entitled to such surplus.

16. Beneficiary may, from time to time, appoint a successor or successors to any Trustee named herein or to any successor trustee appointed hereunder. Upon such appointment, and without conveyance to the successor trustee, the latter shall be vested with all title, powers and duties conferred upon any Trustee herein named or appointed hereunder. Each such appointment and substitution shall be made by written interest executed by Beneficiary, which, when recorded in the mortgage records of the county or counties in which the property is situated, shall be conclusive proof of proper appointment of the successor trustee.

17. Trustee accepts this trust when this deed, duly executed and acknowledged, is made a public record as provided by law. Trustee is not obligated to notify any party hereto of pending sale under any other deed of trust or of any action or proceeding in which Grantor, Beneficiary or Trustee shall be a party unless such action or proceeding is brought by Trustee.

The Grantor covenants to and agrees with the Beneficiary and the Beneficiary's successors in interest that the Grantor is lawfully seized in fee simple of the real property and has a valid, unencumbered title thereto, except as may be set forth in any addendum or exhibit attached hereto, and that the Grantor will warrant and forever defend the same against all persons whomsoever.

**WARNING:** Unless Grantor provides Beneficiary with evidence of insurance coverage as required by the contract or loan agreement between them, Beneficiary may purchase insurance at Grantor's expense to protect Beneficiary's interest. This insurance may, but need not, also protect Grantor's interest. If the collateral becomes damaged, the coverage purchased by Beneficiary may not pay any claim made by or against Grantor. Grantor is responsible for the cost of any insurance coverage purchased by Beneficiary, which cost may be added to Grantor's contract or loan balance. If it is so added, the interest rate of the underlying contract or loan will apply to it. The effective date of coverage may be the date Grantor's

prior coverage lapsed or the date Grantor failed to provide proof of coverage. **EXHIBIT A****LEGAL DESCRIPTION:**

A tract of land situated in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 39 South, Range 8 East of the Willamette Meridian, in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, said tract also being a portion of vacated Block 22, and vacated 4th Street in West Klamath a duly recorded subdivision, said tract more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the South line of the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of said Section 13, said point of beginning being the intersection of the Northerly line of Holliday Drive and the Westerly line of Third Street also known as the Weyerhaeuser County Road; thence South 41°10' East along the Westerly line of said Third Street a distance of 100 feet; thence continuing along the Westerly line of Third Street along the arc of 321.0 foot radius curve to the right, the long chord of which curve bears South 28°40' East 139.08 feet a distance of 140.19 feet; thence continuing along the Westerly line of Third Street, South 16°10' East (South 16°58'00" East by recorded Survey No. 1178, as recorded in the office of the Klamath County Surveyor) a distance of 120.45 feet to the true point of beginning of this description said true point being South 16°58'00" East a distance of 90.45 feet from the Northwest corner of Parcel 2, as shown on said Survey No. 1178, and the true point of beginning of that tract of land described in Deed Volume M-77 at page 20214, as recorded in the Klamath County Deed Records; thence continuing South 16°58'00" East, along the Westerly right of way line of said Third Street, 145.20 feet; thence South 73°02'00" West 300.00 feet to the Westerly right of way line of said vacated Fourth Street; thence North 16°58'00" West, along the Westerly right of way line of said vacated Fourth Street, 145.20 feet; thence North 73°02'00" East 300.00 feet to the true point of beginning of this description
