




That portion of Government Lot 5, Section 20, Township 39 South, Range 11 1/2 East of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon, lying Southerly of the new channel of Lost River taken by the United States of America in Federal Court Civil Case No. 4309, and the description of which is set forth in Klamath County Deed Book 232, page 156 and lying Westerly of the following described tract of land conveyed to Klamath Basin Improvement District: A portion of Lot 5, Section 20, Township 39 South, Range 11 1/2 E.W.M., 80 feet wide extending between the Southeast line of Lost River and the Northwest line of Klamath Irrigation District "F" Canal, and lying 40 feet on each side of the following described line: Beginning at a point on the Northwesterly right of way line of the Klamath Irrigation District "F" Canal, opposite centerline Station 220+09.0 from whence the Southwest corner of Section 20, Township 39 S., Range 11 1/2 E.W.M., bears the following courses S 32°14' E. 44.0 feet; thence West 1022.3 feet; thence from said point of beginning N. 32°14' W. 555 Feet, more or less, to the Southerly shore line of Lost River.
