POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, John F. Marshall, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do hereby make, constitute and appoint Patricia Anne Shuck, my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name, place and stead, and for my use and benefit to sell and convey to any party or parties at such price or prices and upon such terms as shall seem meet, all or any portion of the following described real property situate, lying and being in the county of Klamath, in the state of Oregon, and more particularly described, as follows, to-wit:

PARCEL 1:

with all of the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and for me and in my name to make out, execute, acknowledge and deliver property deeds of conveyance of the same with or without covenants of seizin, freedom from encumbrances and warranty.

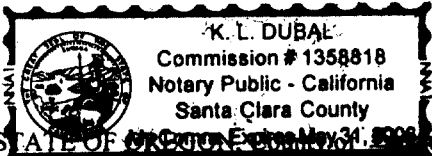
