REVOCABLE LICENSE & ENCROACHMENT PERMIT

The City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, a municipal corporation (City) and Jim Mieloszyk (Grantee) for and in consideration of the covenants and conditions hereinafter set forth, agree as follows:

City hereby gives and grants to Grantee, its successors and assigns, upon the terms and subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, non-exclusive permission to encroach upon a portion of the alley at 2424 Shasta Way and the adjoining Lark Street rights-of-way in the City of Klamath Falls (as shown on the attached map Exhibit "A"). This license/permit is granted for the limited purpose of: 1) allowing a variance to CDO Section 14.390 vision clearance setbacks at alleyway & Lark Street; and 2) allowing the fence to remain at a distance of 26' from the center of Lark Street. The license/permit is subject to the following conditions:

- 1) Grantee shall comply with all relevant local, state and federal regulations pertaining to Grantee's use of the area, including but not limited to, City Planning and building regulations;
- Grantee shall submit the as-built construction plans to the City's Public Works Department and shall conform to any modifications or restrictions imposed by the Department; and
- Grantee shall be responsible for the maintenance of the fence, for all expenses for removal of the fence, if required under this license/permit, and for restoration of the right-of-way damaged by maintenance or removal.

Grantee agrees to pay to the City, as compensation for the privileges herein granted, the sum of Eighty-One Dollars (\$81.00), receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by City.


