Subordination Agreement

THIS SUBORDINATION AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made this 16 April, 2003, by The Chase Manhattan Bank as Indenture Trustee, Residential Funding Corporation, Attorney in Fact ("Subordinating Lender").
