

Klamath County is holding a public comment period from November 17, 2003 to November 25, 2003, during which time you may comment on the draft Chiloquin Mill Restoration Project's Brownfields Cleanup Grant Proposal. The draft proposal is available for review at the following locations:

Klamath County will hold a public meeting on November 24th, 2003, at Chiloquin High School, 300 Elm Street, Chiloquin. The meeting will start at 6:30 p.m. After a brief presentation, Klamath County staff will take questions and comments from the public on the grant proposal.

Comments must be received by 1:00 p.m. November 25, 2003. Once the public comment period ends, Klamath County will review all comments received and will incorporate suggested changes into the grant proposal as appropriate. If no significant changes are made, the Brownfields Cleanup Grant Proposal will be considered final and the application will be submitted to the Environmental Protection Agency.
