REVOCABLE LICENSE & ENCROACHMENT PERMIT

The City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, a municipal corporation (City) and William E. Adams (Grantee) for and in consideration of the covenants and conditions hereinafter set forth, agree as follows:

City hereby gives and grants to Grantee, its successors and assigns, upon the terms and subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, non-exclusive permission to encroach upon a portion of the Gage Road right-of-way between Highway 97 and Lakeport Boulevard in the City of Klamath Falls (as shown on the attached map Exhibit "A"). This license/permit is granted for the limited purpose of installing a fence and is subject to the following conditions:

- 1) Grantee shall comply with all relevant local, state and federal regulations pertaining to Grantee's use of the area, including but not limited to, City Planning and building regulations;
- 2) Grantee shall submit the as-built construction plans to the City's Public Works Department and shall conform to any modifications or restrictions imposed by the Department as noted in Exhibit "B"; and
- 3) Grantee shall be responsible for the maintenance of the fence for all expenses for removal of the fence, if required under this license/permit, and for restoration of the right-of-way damaged by maintenance or removal.

Grantee agrees to pay to the City, as compensation for the privileges herein granted, the sum of Eighty-One Dollars (\$81.00), receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by City.



REVOCABLE LICENSE & ENCROACHMENT PERMIT #010-04

Encroachment on Gage Road Right-Of-Way

Conditions: 1) Grantee shall allow the City access across the existing gated street. The City Wastewater Division can place their lock by connecting it to Grantee's lock. The City has a Sanitary Manhole that is located in the westerly prolongation of Gage Road. Currently the City uses Gage Road to gain access to that manhole. 2) Grantee shall check with the City Planning office on fence permits and shall not commence construction prior to obtaining a permit if required. 3) Grantee shall call for utility locates prior to excavating for fence posts. 4) Grantee shall have a Professional Land Surveyor locate the south right-of-way line of Gage Road so that the fence does not encroach onto private property. 5) Grantee shall not store or build any structure other than the fence within the right-of-way which would impede the City's access.
