**WHEREAS**, Oregon Administrative Rules 333-255-070, Paragraphs (4) (a) and (6) (a) requires that an ambulance providing Intermediate or Advanced Life Support (ALS) level care have a minimum staff of two persons, one either at Intermediate or Paramedic level, the other at or above the EMT-Basic level; and,


**WHEREAS**, OAR 333-250-050 section (c) requires submission via the county governing body; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Saddle Mountain Volunteer Ambulance Service requests approval to submit a request for a variance to permit the Intermediate and ALS ambulance to be staffed with Intermediate or Paramedic and non-EMT driver at those times when an EMT-Basic or Intermediate is not available for the run; and,


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Klamath County Board of Commissioners grants approval to request the State of Oregon to grant a variance allowing the Saddle Mountain Volunteer Ambulance Service to staff the ambulance with only one person at the EMT-Basic or Intermediate level and a non-EMT driver at those times when an EMT-Basic or Intermediate is not available.
