The Klamath County Board of Commissioners and Property Sales Department invite written sealed bids from qualified licensed Contractors for the Demolition and Cleanup activities on the real property, described as Lot 17, Block 9, Midland, Klamath County, Oregon. Together with a 1962 Kit, VIN #55X3FD3S278, X-081985, according to the official plat thereof on file in the office of the County Clerk of Klamath County, Oregon, otherwise known as 115 Hollyhock Lane, Midland, Klamath County, Oregon.

A mandatory pre-bid conference is scheduled to be held at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 2, 2004, at the demolition and cleanup (115 Hollyhock Ln., Midland) site, Klamath County, Oregon. If a bidder does not attend the mandatory pre-bid conference and submits a bid, the bid shall be rejected and not considered, and be returned unopened to the bidder.

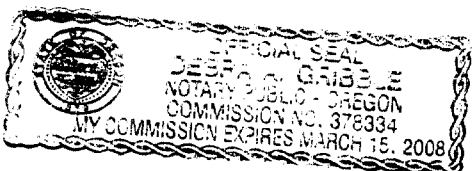

A written sealed bid in an envelope marked "Demolition and Cleanup - 115 Hollyhock Ln., Midland" shall be delivered or mailed to Linda Seater, Property Manager, Property Sales Dept., 305 Main St., Rm. 238, K Falls, OR 97601. No bid will be considered if received later than 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 9, 2004. The bids will be opened and read aloud at 10:15 a.m. on September 9, 2004, in the Public Works Dept's Conference Rm. #232, located at 305 Main St., K Falls, OR 97601.

Bid security in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid price must accompany the bid. All contractors and subcontractors performing work on this project must be currently registered and licensed with the Oregon Construction Contractors Board. Pursuant to ORS 279.029, 279.111 and 305.380 through 305.385 a bidder will be required to complete a Bidder Residency Statement, Certificate of Non-Discrimination and a Certificate of Compliance with Oregon Tax Laws.

Klamath County may reject any bid not in compliance with all prescribed public bidding procedures and requirements, and may for good cause reject any or all bids upon a finding of the

agency if it is in the public interest to do so. Klamath County also reserves the right to waive any informalities. All bids are subject to Oregon Law bid procedures. #6912 August 22, 2004.
