UNDERGROUND RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT

For value received, City of Klamath Falls, an Oregon municipal corporation, and Klamath Wingwatchers, Inc, an Oregon nonprofit corporation, ("Grantor"), hereby grant to PacifiCorp, an Oregon corporation, its successors and assigns, ("Grantee"), a perpetual, non-exclusive right of way easement for the construction, reconstruction, operation, maintenance, repair, replacement, enlargement, and removal of Grantee's underground electric distribution and communication lines and all necessary or desirable accessories and appurtenances thereto, including, without limitation: fibers, cables and other conductors and conduits therefore; and pads, transformers, switches and vaults; on, across, and under a strip of land 10 feet in width, located on real property of Grantor in Klamath County, State of Oregon. The "Easement Area" is more particularly described and shown on Exhibit A, attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein. The property burdened by this easement is described in Exhibit B, attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein.

This Easement shall include the right of access to the right of way from adjacent lands of Grantor for all activities in connection with the purposes for which this easement has been granted; and together with the present and (without payment therefore) the future right to keep the right of way clear of all brush, trees, timber, structures, buildings and other hazards which might endanger Grantee's facilities or impede Grantee's activities. This easement may be in close proximity to Grantor's utility lines, and, if so, Grantee shall, if required, comply with City clearance/shielding standards and coordinate installation with Grantor's Engineering unit.

At no time shall Grantor place, light any fires, place or store any flammable materials (other than agricultural crops), on or within the boundaries of the right of way. Subject to the foregoing limitations, the surface of the right of way may be used for public park purposes and other purposes not inconsistent, as determined by Grantee, with the purposes for which this easement has been granted.


