MEMORANDUM OF ANNEXATION AGREEMENT

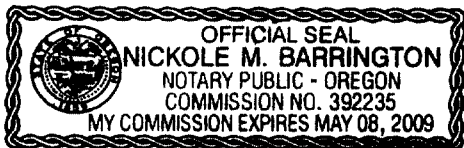

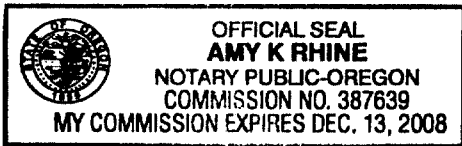
