Notice was sent out to 10 surrounding property owners as well as 2 agencies of concern. No negative response was received from any of the notified parties.

A Variance shall be granted only upon finding by review authority that it satisfies the following criteria:

- A. That the literal enforcement of this Code would result in practical difficulty or unnecessary hardship.
- B. That the condition causing the difficulty was not created by the applicant.
- C. That the granting of the Variance will not be detrimental to the public health, safety, and welfare or to the use and enjoyment of adjacent properties and will not be contrary to the intent of this code.

Literal enforcement of the Code would cause unnecessary hardship because of the lot size and location of the existing home. Applicant wishes to establish a garage and carport addition to the existing home on the south side.

The condition causing the difficulty was not created by the applicant. The lot size and shape and location of the home create the difficulty.

In review of this application, it would appear not to be detrimental to the adjacent properties or to the public. Ten surrounding property owners were notified of this request. No negative response was received from any of the notified parties.
