## TRUSTEE'S DEED

THIS INDENTURE, made on 9/13/2006, between REGIONAL TRUSTEE SERVICES CORPORATION, hereinafter called Trustee, and JP MORGAN CHASE BANK, AS TRUST ADMINISTRATOR, ON BEHALF OF THE HOLDERS OF THE CSFB MORTGAGE BACKED PASS-THROUGH CERTIFICATES SERIES 2002-18, hereinafter called the Grantee; and the true and actual consideration paid for this transfer is the sum of \$84,824.52.

WITNESSETH:

RECITALS: LEAH PARAZOO AND SHANE PARAZOO, AS TENANTS BY THE ENTIRETY, as Grantor, executed and delivered to AMERITITLE, as Trustee, for the benefit of MORTGAGE ELECTRONIC REGISTRATION SYSTEMS, INC. AS NOMINEE FOR ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, as Beneficiary, a certain Trust Deed dated 1/10/2002, duly recorded on 1/17/2002 in Volume M02, page 3337, of Deeds of Trust, under Instrument No. , records of KLAMATH County, OREGON. In said Trust Deed the real property therein and hereinafter described was conveyed by said Grantor to said Trustee to secure, among other things, the performance of certain obligations of the Grantor to the said Beneficiary. The said Grantor thereafter defaulted in his performance of the obligations secured by said Trust Deed as stated in the Notice of Default hereinafter mentioned and such default still existed at the time of the said sale hereinafter described.

By reason of said default, the owner and holder of the obligations secured by said Trust Deed, being the Beneficiary therein named, or his successor in interest, declared all sums to secured immediately due and owing; and Notice of Default, containing an election to sell the said real property and to foreclose said Trust Deed by advertisement and sale to satisfy Grantor's said obligations was recorded in the mortgage records of said county on 5/10/2006, in Instrument No. MO6 PAGE35505 to which reference is now made.

After the recording of said Notice of Default, as aforesaid, the undersigned Trustee gave notice of the time for and place of sale of said real property as fixed by Trustee as required by law; copies of the Trustee's Notice of Sale were served pursuant to ORCP 7D(2) and 7D(3) or mailed by both first class and certified mail with return receipt requested, to the last known address of the persons or their legal representatives, if any, named in ORS 86.740(1) and (2)(a), at least 120 days before the date the property was sold, and the Trustee's Notice of Sale was mailed by first class and certified mail with return receipt requested, to the last-known address of the guardian, conservator or administrator or executor of any person named in ORS 86.740(1), promptly after the Trustee received knowledge of the disability, insanity or death of any such person; the Notice of Sale was served upon occupants of the property described in the Trust Deed in the manner in which a summons is served pursuant to ORCP 7D(2) and 7D(3) at least 120 days before the date the property was sold, pursuant to ORS 86.750(1). If the foreclosure proceedings were stayed and released from the stay, copies of an Amended Notice of Sale in the form required by ORS 86.755(6) were mailed by registered or certified mail to the last-known address of those persons listed in ORS 86.740 and 86.750(1) and to the address provided by each person who was present at the time and place set for the sale which was stayed within 30 days after the release from the stay. Further, the Trustee published a copy of said Notice of Sale in a newspaper of general circulation in each county in which the said real property is situated, once a week for four successive weeks; the last publication of said Notice occurred more than twenty days prior to the date of such sale.

### PARCEL 1:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of said Section 15, Township 34 South, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian, and running; thence along the North line of said Section North 89 degrees 42' 15" East 400 feet; thence South 62.42 feet; thence South 46 degrees 57' 20" West 408.82 feet to the Northeasterly bank of the Williamson River; thence following said river bank North 37 degrees 53' 20" West 136.90 feet; thence North 16 degrees 33' West 60.98 feet to the West line of Section 15; thence Northerly on said Section line 172.92 feet to the point of beginning.

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Section 15, Township 34 South, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian, and running; thence North 89 degrees 42' 15" East 400.0 feet along the North line of said Section 15; thence South 62.42 feet; thence South 50 degrees 43' 50" East 453.16 feet; thence South 76 degrees 17' 30" East 886.79 feet to the true point of beginning of this description; thence South 35 degrees 56' 30" West 446.55 feet to a point on the Northeasterly bank of the Williamson River; thence South 45 degrees 32' 20" East 84.00 feet; thence North 44 degrees 52' 10" East 411.58 feet; thence North 34 degrees 25' 40" West 156.01 feet, more or less, to the true point of beginning of this description.
