2.6 Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Credit Union in writing prior to doing so and Credit Union's interest in the Property is not ignorarized.

4.5 Association of Unit Owners. In the event the Real Property has been submitted to unit ownership pursuant to a Unit Ownership Law, or similar law for the establishment of condominiums or cooperative ownership of Real Property, the insurance may be carried by the association of unit owners in Grantor's behalf, and the proceeds of such insurance may be paid to the association of unit owners for the purpose of repairing or reconstructing the Property. If not so used by the association, such proceeds shall be paid to Credit Union.

4.6 Insurance Reserves. Subject to any limitations set by applicable law, Credit Union may require Borrower to maintain with Credit Union reserves for payment of insurance premiums, which reserves shall be created by monthly payments of a sum estimated by Credit Union to be sufficient to produce, at least 15 days before due, amounts at least equal to the insurance premiums to be paid. If 15 days before payment is due the reserve funds are insufficient, Borrower shall upon demand pay any deficiency to Credit Union. The reserve funds shall be held by Credit Union as a general deposit from Borrower and shall constitute a noninterest bearing debt from Credit Union to Borrower, which Credit Union may satisfy by payment of the insurance premiums required to be paid by Borrower as they become due. Credit Union does not hold the reserve funds in trust for Borrower, and Credit Union is not the agent of Borrower for payment of the insurance premiums required to be paid by Borrower.

5. **Expenditure by Credit Union.** If Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Deed of Trust, including the obligation to maintain the prior Indebtedness in good standing as required by Section 17, Credit Union may at its option on Grantor's behalf pay amounts to cure any default in the prior Indebtedness and any amount that it expends in so doing shall be added to the Indebtedness. Amounts so added shall be payable in accordance with the terms of the Indebtedness. The rights provided for in this section shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Credit Union may be entitled on account of the default. Credit Union shall not by taking the required action cure the default so as to bar it from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

6. **Warranty; Defense of Title.**6.1 **Title.** Grantor warrants that it holds marketable title to the Property in fee simple free of all encumbrances other than those set forth in Section 17 or in any policy of title insurance issued in favor of Credit Union in connection with the Deed of Trust.

6.2 **Defense of Title.** Subject to the exceptions in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Credit Union or Trustee under this Deed of Trust, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense.

 7.1 Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned, Credit Union may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the Indebtedness. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor, Credit Union, or Trustee in connection with the condemnation.

 7.2 Proceedings. If any proceedings in condemnation are filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Credit Union in writing and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award.

 8. Imposition of Tax By State.

 8.1 State Taxes Covered. The following shall constitute state taxes to which this section applies:

 (a) A specific tax upon trust deeds or upon all or any part of the Indebtedness secured by a trust deed or security agreement.

 (b) A specific tax on a Grantor which the taxpayer is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the Indebtedness secured by a trust deed or security agreement.

(b) A specific tax on a Grantor which the taxpayer is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the Indebtedness secured by a trust deed or security agreement.

(c) A tax on a trust deed or security agreement chargeable against the Credit Union or the holder of the Agreement secured.

9. Power and Obligations of Trustee.

9.1 Powers of Trustee. In addition to all powers of Trustee arising as a matter of law, Trustee shall have the power to take the following actions with respect to the Property upon the request of Credit Union and Grantor:

(a) Join in preparing and filing a map or plat of the Real Property, including the dedication of streets or other rights in the public.

(b) Join in granting any easement or creating any restriction on the Real Property.

(c) Join in any subordination or other agreement affecting this Deed of Trust or the interest of Credit Union under this Deed of Trust.

9.2 Obligations to Notify. Trustee shall not be obligated to notify any other party of a pending sale under any other trust deed or lien, or of any action or proceeding in which Grantor. Credit Union, or Trustee shall be a party, unless the action or proceeding is brought by Trustee.

10. Transfer by Grantor.

10.1 Consent by Credit Union. Grantor shall not transfer or agree to transfer all or part of Grantor's interest in the Property without the prior written consent of Credit Union. Any attempt to transfer shall entitle the Credit Union to terminate and accelerate the Indebtedness under this Deed of Trust.

A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of real property or any right, title, or interest therein, whether legal or equitable, whether voluntary or involuntary, by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, land contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three years, lease-option contract, or any other method of conveyance of real property interest. 11. Security Agreement; Financing Statements.

11.1 Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes fixtures, and Credit Union shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code of the state in which the Real Property is located.

11.2 Security Interest. Upon request by Credit Union, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Credit Union to perfect and continue Credit Union's security interest in the Income and Personal Property. Grantor hereby appoints Credit Union as Grantor's attorney in fact for the purpose of executing any documents necessary to perfect or continue this security interest. Credit Union may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, file occupies or reproductions of this Deed of Trust as a financing statement. Grantor will reimburse Credit Union for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property and make it available to Credit Union within three days after receipt of written demand from Credit Union.

Any reconveyance fee or termination fee required by law shall be paid by Grantor.

(2) The value of Grantor's dwelling securing the Indebtedness declines significantly below its appraised value for purposes of the Agreement.

(3) Credit Union reasonably believes that Grantor will not be able to meet the repayment requirements of the Agreement due to a material change

14 Actions Upon Termination.

14.1 Remedies. Upon the occurrence of any termination and at any time thereafter, Trustee or Credit Union may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

(a) With respect to all or any part of the Real Property, the Trustee shall have the right to foreclose by judicial foreclosure, in either case in accordance with and to the full extent provided by applicable law.

(b) With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Credit Union shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform

Commercial Code in effect in the state in which the Credit Union is located.

(c) Credit Union shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Income, including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Credit Union. If the income is collected by Credit Union, then Grantor irrevocably designates Credit Union as Grantor's attorney in fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to Credit Union in response to Credit Union's demand shall satisfy the obligation for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Credit Union may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

(d) Credit Union shall have the right to have a receiver appointed to take possession of any or all of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Income from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above cost of the receivership, against the Indebtedness. The receiver

(f) If the Real Property is submitted to unit ownership, Credit Union or its designee may vote on any matter that may come before the members of the association of unit owners, pursuant to the power of attorney granted Credit Union in Section 16.2.

(g) Trustee and Credit Union shall have any other right or remedy provided in this Deed of Trust, or the Note.

14.2 Sale of the Property. In exercising its rights and remedies, the Trustee or Credit Union, shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, or to sell certain portions of the Property and refrain from selling other portions. Credit Union shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

14.3 Notice of Sale. Credit Union shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten days before the time of the sale or disposition.
