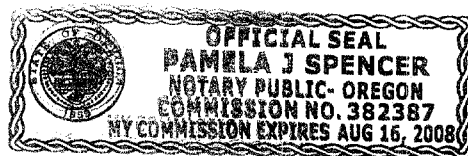
## PLEASE SEE ABOVE REFERENCED TRUST DEED.
