
**STATUTORY WARRANTY DEED**

Government Lot 1 in Section 35, Township 35 South, Range 12 East, Willamette Meridian, in Beatty, Klamath County, Oregon, commonly known as the Paiute Cemetery. Containing 2.75 acres more or less.
