

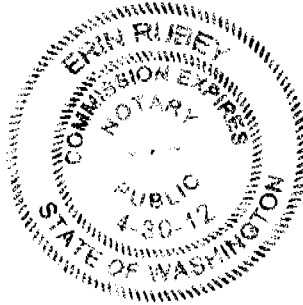

TRUSTEE'S NOTICE OF SALE

A default has occurred under the terms of a trust deed made by Charles F. Bennett and Michelle M.
