EASEMENT (in Gross) STREAM GAGING STATION

JWTR, LLC, Grantor, grants to the State of Oregon, acting through the Oregon Water Resources Department, Grantee, a permanent easement in gross for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a stream gaging station for monitoring stream levels, to be housed in a covered structure (a "gage house"), together with orifice lines and outside staff gage (the "Station"), to be located upon the following real property of Grantor, together with a right of ingress and egress to the Station for the purpose of construction, operation and maintenance of the Station only:

Real property of Grantor located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Township 39 S, Range 7 E, WM, Klamath County, Oregon (Tax Lot 200)

Grantee shall locate the Station on a concrete foundation on the east bank of Spencer Creek, with orifice lines running from the gage house down the bank in a shallow trench to the stream, and shall maintain the Station in a good, safe, and workmanlike manner. Grantee may locate a bank operated cableway system near the gage house for the purpose of measuring high stream flows and fencing if needed to protect the Station. The cableway system includes a cable running across the stream to steel posts on concrete pads. Grantee may locate a staff gage in the creek. To the extent permitted by Article XI, Section 7 of the Oregon Constitution, and subject to the limits of the Oregon Tort Claims Act, ORS 30.260 through 30.300, Grantee shall indemnify and hold Grantor harmless from any damages or claims arising from Grantee's use of the easement and operation of the Station on Grantor's property.

The Station and all equipment and tools for its maintenance and use placed upon Grantor's property are the property of Grantee and may be removed by Grantee at its cost and expense. Upon removal or relocation of the Station Grantee shall

restore Grantor's property to as near as possible the same state and condition existing prior to installation of the Station.

This easement runs with the land and is binding upon the successors and transferees of Grantor and the successors, assignees and transferees of Grantee.

This easement is granted subject to all prior easements or encumbrances of record on the above described property.

The true consideration for this conveyance is other value given.
