Kelly called trustee, and Rogue River Mortgage, LLC hereinafter called the second party; WITNESSETH: Ore-Cal Land Development LLC RECITALS: ____, as grantor, executed and Pacific Trust Deed Servicing Company, Inc., an Oregon Corp., as trustee, for the benefit september 19, 2007 of Rogue River Mortgage, LLC dated September 10, 2007 .____ recorded on ___ County, Oregon, in booksynedsworms works and/or as feesing/instrument/migroxibra/reception: No2007-016508 dicate which). In that trust deed, the real property therein and hereinafter described was conveyed by the grantor to the trustee to secure, among other things, the performance of certain obligations of the grantor to the beneficiary. Copies of the notice of sale were served upon occupants of the property described in the trust deed in the manner in which a summons is served pursuant to ORCP 7 D. (2) and 7 D. (3) at least 120 days before the date the property was sold, pursuant to ORS 86.750 (1).
