1. Property affected: A portion of T36S R12E S14 - tax lot 2099, Beatty, Klamath County, Oregon.  
Description of impacted area is included as Exhibit A.
2. In accordance with the Conditional No Further Action decision issued by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) on September 1, 2010, contamination originating from the former New Beatty Store (adjacent Tax Lot 2100) has migrated onto the referenced property. Site investigations have been performed and the full magnitude and extent of contamination have been determined. Contaminated soil is present at depths exceeding 15-feet below ground surface (bgs); contaminated groundwater is present at depths exceeding 10.5-feet bgs. The contaminant plume was stabilized in 1999 by the removal of the source of the contamination: a leaking underground storage tank system.
3. The purpose of this Notice is to document the location of existing contamination. DEQ should be notified of any proposed actions at the property described in this Notice that might result in excavation within the contaminated areas.
