1. Property affected: A portion of T36S R12E S14: tax lot 1800, 24211 Godowa Springs Road, Beatty, Klamath County, Oregon. A description of the area of the deed notice is included as Exhibit A.
2. In accordance with the Conditional No Further Action decision issued by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) on September 1, 2010, contamination originating from the former New Beatty Store has migrated onto the referenced property. Site investigations have been performed, the full magnitude and extent of contamination have been determined. Contaminated groundwater is present at depths exceeding 11-feet below ground surface (bgs); contaminated soil is present at depths greater than 7.5-feet bgs. The contaminant plume is now stable due to the removal of the source of the contamination - a leaking underground storage tank system - from the nearby Tax Lot 2100.
3. The purpose of this Notice is to document the location of the contamination. DEQ should be notified of any proposed actions at the property described in this Notice that might result in excavation within the contaminated areas.
