- 1. Property affected: A portion of T36S R12E S14 tax lot 2100, 42615 Hwy 140 E, Beatty, Klamath County, Oregon. Description of area impacted is included as Exhibit A.
- 2. In accordance with the Conditional No Further Action decision issued by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) on September 1, 2010, contamination originates from and remains on the former New Beatty Store property. Site investigations have been performed, the full magnitude and extent of contamination have been determined. Contaminated soil is present at depths exceeding 15-feet below ground surface (bgs); contaminated groundwater is present at depths exceeding 10.5-feet bgs. The contaminant plume was stabilized by the removal of the source of the contamination - a leaking underground storage tank system – located on Tax Lot 2100.
- 3. The purpose of this Notice is to document the location of the contamination. DEQ should be notified of any proposed actions at the property described in this Notice that might result in excavation within the contaminated areas.
