1. Property affected: **A portion of T38S R09E S29 – City Right of Way adjacent to 1355 Esplanade Ave, Klamath Falls, Klamath County, Oregon.** Description of impacted area is included as Exhibit A.
2. In accordance with the No Further Action decision issued by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) on December 28, 2010, contamination originating from an underground storage tank located on Tax Lot 5500 (Former Herald & News) has migrated onto the referenced property. Site investigations have been performed and the full magnitude and extent of contamination have been determined. Contaminated soil is present at depths exceeding 5-feet below ground surface (bgs). The contaminant plume was stabilized in 1998 by the removal of the source of the contamination: a leaking underground storage tank system.
3. The purpose of this Notice is to document the location of existing contamination. DEQ should be notified of any proposed actions at the property described in this Notice that might result in excavation within the contaminated area. 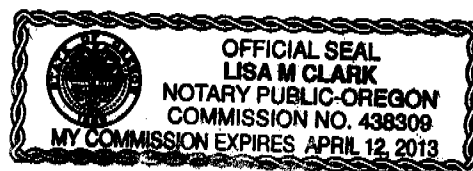


FIGURE 14: EXTENT OF GASOLINE IN SOIL 3.5 – 8 FEET BGS
