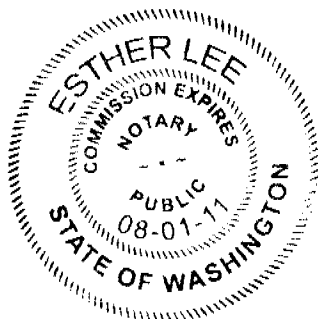

## NOTICE TO RESIDENTIAL TENANTS

The property in which you are living is in foreclosure. A foreclosure sale is scheduled for June 22, 2011. Unless the lender who is foreclosing on this property is paid, the foreclosure will go through and someone new will own this property.
