
This cover sheet relates to the Assignment of Promissory Note and Trust Deed attached

ASSIGNMENT OF PROMISSORY NOTE AND TRUST DEED

I, Louis Zarosinski, hereby assign to myself and my wife, Josephine H. Zarosinski, as joint tenants with the right of survivorship, all of my rights and interest in and under the promissory note in the original principal amount of \$75,000 dated November 2, 2004, executed in favor of me and others by Raul M.
