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SPECIAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

THIS IS A MILITARY POWER OF ATTORNEY PREPARED AND EXECUTED PURSUANT TO TITLE 10, UNITED STATES CODE, SECTION 1044B, BY A PERSON AUTHORIZED TO RECEIVE LEGAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE MILITARY SERVICES. FEDERAL LAW EXEMPTS A MILITARY POWER OF ATTORNEY FROM ANY REQUIREMENT OF FORM, SUBSTANCE, FORMALITY OR RECORDING THAT IS PROVIDED FOR POWERS OF ATTORNEY BY THE LAW OF ANY STATE, COMMONWEALTH, TERRITORY, DISTRICT, OR POSSESSION OF THE UNITED STATES. FEDERAL LAW SPECIFIES THAT A MILITARY POWER OF ATTORNEY SHALL BE GIVEN THE SAME LEGAL EFFECT AS A POWER OF ATTORNEY PREPARED AND EXECUTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAWS OF THE JURISDICTION WHERE IT IS PRESENTED.

Whipple, a legal resident of Oregon and presently residing at New Kabul Compound, Afghanistan, desiring to execute a SPECIAL POWER OF ATTORNEY, do hereby appoint MARK T. WHIPPLE whose address is 22711 Highway 36, Cheshire, Oregon 97419, as my Attorney-in-Fact to act as follows, GRANTING unto my said Attorney full power-to:

Purchase, enter upon, and take possession of a single real estate property located at, 13710 Sprague River Road, Chiloquin, Oregon 97624, together with all improvements thereon, in my name and for an amount he, in the exercise of sound judgment, deems best, but at the amount not to exceed \$249,000. Sign in my name any notes, mortgages, banking applications for financing and insurance policies, and to do any and all acts necessary for the purchase of this property, to include all actions necessary to secure a loan in my name for the purchase of this property.

TERMINATION: This Power of Attorney shall become null and void the 28th day of October, 2012 unless I should become incapacitated; in that case, it shall remain in effect until revoked by me.


